# BATHING ROOM: DRYING STATIONS

**!** *Wire shelf installed upside down to create lip to keep dryers from sliding*

- Wired Closet Shelving from Lowe's or Home Depot
- Drying Table hook assembly
  1. Mock up the 2x6 by placing it in the shelf mounts and marking where mounts line up on the 2x6.
  2. Mark 2 screw hook locations in between each mount.
  3. Drill all of your holes on the 2x6 before you hang so you can secure through pilot holes
  4. After you drill, place the 2x6 in the mounts and mark on steel mounts through the pilot holes
  5. Use 3" steel screws so you can reach through the 2x6, shelf mounts, and stud. Secure with a washer

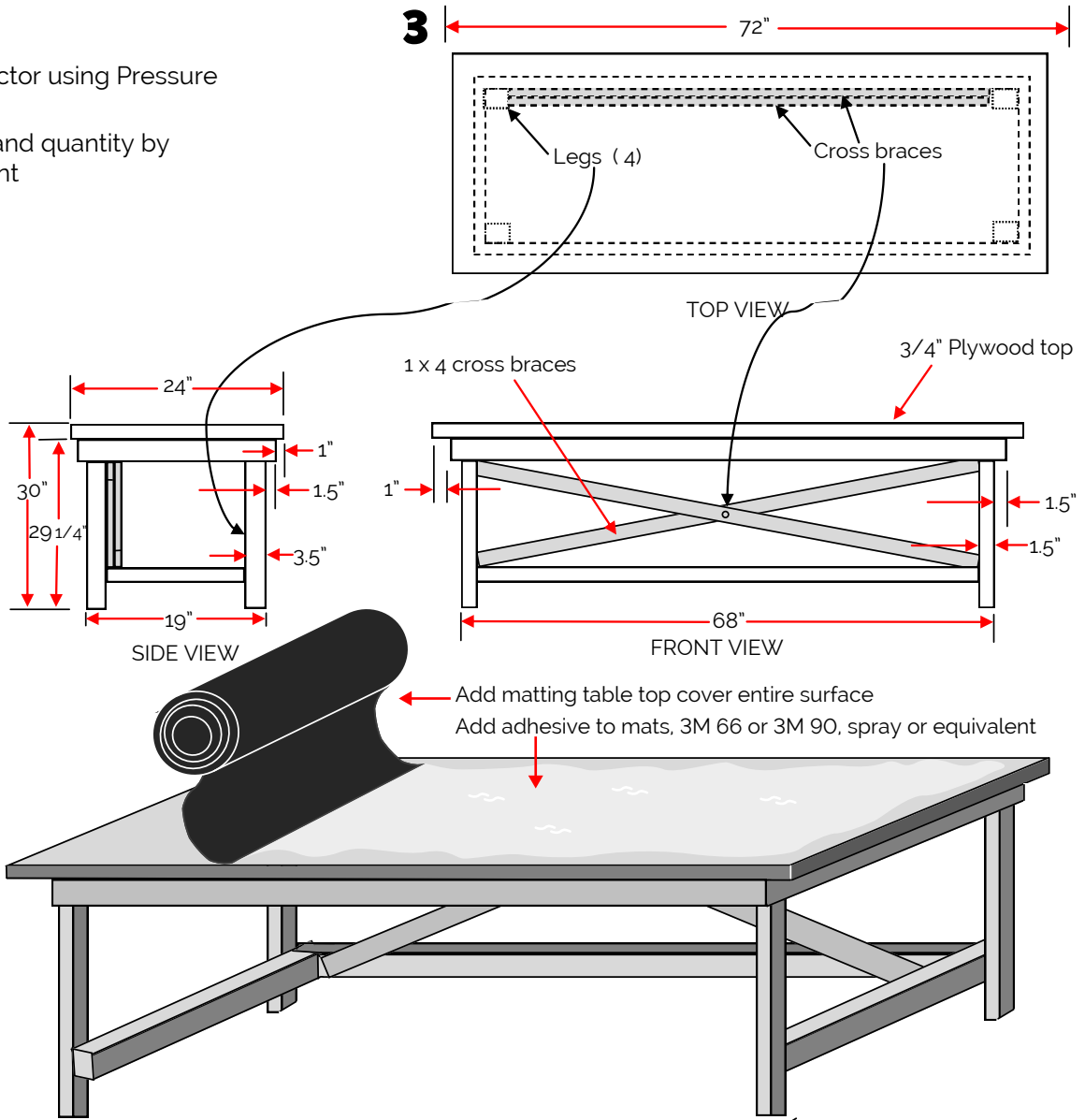

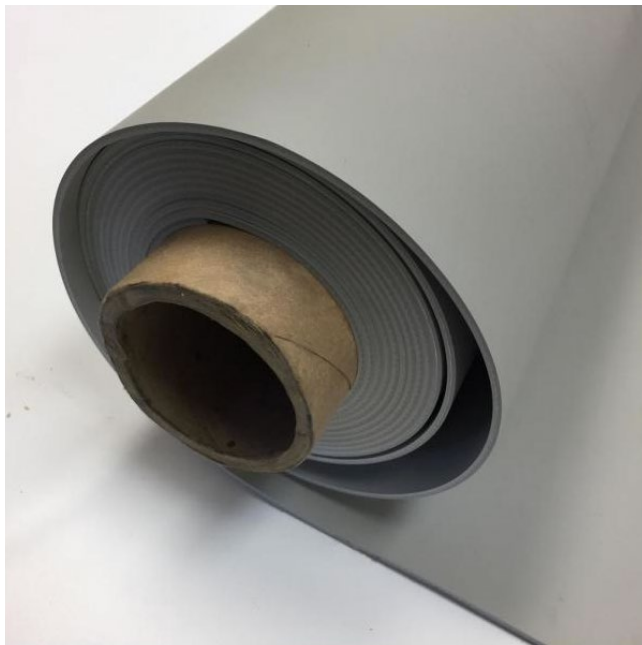
# SOUND PROOFING

## Sound Proofing:

Sound proofing is not required by the Franchiser. This is an option that needs to be discussed with the Franchise Owner and in guidelines with what is required /outlined within the lease. In the event sound proofing is required, then the franchiser would recommend the following product, or something similar, based on lease requirements. Sound engineer determines requirements.

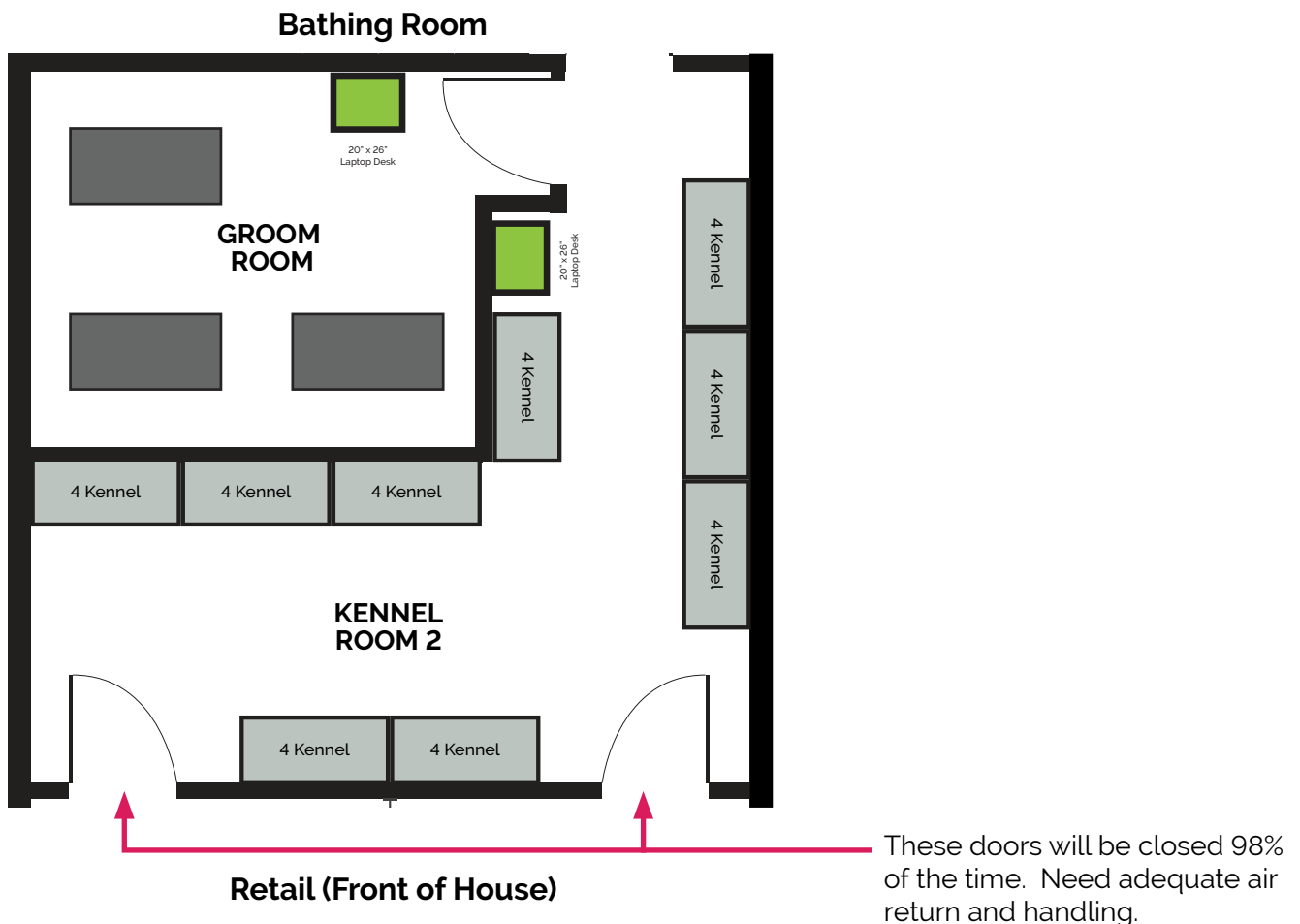
# FIRE SPRINKLERS/HVAC SYSTEM

## Fire Sprinkler System -

Fire Sprinkler System modifications, based on local code, should be provided by the project architect. The Franchisor is willing to modify the floor plan to help save cost by utilizing the existing sprinkler system. Should this be necessary, prior approval from the Franchisor is required.

## HVAC System -

HVAC system modification for the proper air flow should be provided by the project architect. A minimum of 1 supply and return should be in every room. See architectural plans for more details.

# BATHING STATION ASSEMBLY

- Assemble the tubs BEFORE MOUNTING the Bather Box and shampoo racks on the wall as to know where the comfortable height above the tub will be.
- Situate so that the shampoo rack is slightly lower than the Bather Box to help the siphon, but still make it within reach to change out shampoos easily.
- Install the Bather Box on the same side as the faucet and 5" above the back wall of the tub, let the rinse hose lay over the right side into the tub.
- The shampoo rack should be placed to the side of the tub when possible and the top of the rack 2" below the top of the tub. If space does not permit, the rack should be directly on top of the tub and the Bather Box should be 7" above the tub.

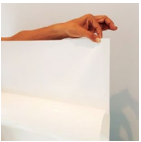
# WALL MURAL INSTALLATION



**STEP 1: PREP YOUR WALL** Proper preparation of your wall is critical! Repair any visible defects, smooth out bumps and patch holes to ensure your wall is smooth and flat. If possible, remove all picture hooks, light fixtures and switch plates. Wash of any dirt, hair, dust or residue from old wallpaper with a dry cloth or a duster. Do NOT use water! A perfectly clean wall will help the adhesive backing to keep its stickiness if repositioning is required.



**STEP 2: GETTING READY** Open the sturdy Eazywallz packaging tube. Inside you will find your wall mural. Look for the panel number on the back of each one. Panel#1 is the first panel on the left. Unroll all panels and lay them flat on the floor, the printed side facing the ceiling. You may notice creases and/or bubbles as you unroll the panels. No worries, this is normal. The creases will disappear once the mural is flattened on the wall.



**STEP 3: PEEL YOUR EAZYWALLZ** Peel off the liner a few inches only across the top of the first panel. Do NOT peel off the entire liner all at once.



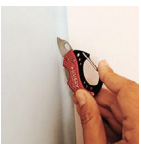
**STEP 4: STICK IT! (PART 1)** Remember that the success of the installation will depend on properly placing the first panel. Stick the top left corner of the panel to the top left corner of your wall. This is the easiest place to start. Using a smoothing tool or squeegee, smooth the top of the panel onto the wall. Do NOT use pressure to avoid any scratches.



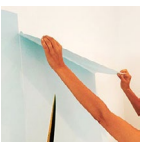
**STEP 4: STICK IT! (PART 2)** Peel off the rest of the panel by gradually and evenly pulling down the liner, a few inches at a time. We recommend having the other person hold the bottom of the panel as you work your way down. Once the first panel is applied, and if necessary, remove any bubbles by gently pushing them outward with the squeegee.



**STEP 5: ADDITIONAL PANELS** Start by aligning Panel#2 to Panel#1. Simply stick the panel against the edge of the first one, by matching the pattern of the mural. Follow STEP 4 above to apply the rest of Panel#2. Repeat the same process to apply all additional panels.



**STEP 6: TRIM OVERAGE** Once all panels have been applied, SLOWLY trim all the overage with an utility knife with a sharp blade (ie: Xacto knife). Follow the edges of your wall or ceiling to do so. You can also use a ruler to cut through a straight line. If needed, repeat this process to cut around outlets, fuse boxes, windows, doors, etc.



**STEP 7: REMOVAL PROCESS** Slowly and gently pull the panels from the wall. Use your hand to gradually hold back the wall mural during this process. To avoid any damage to your wall while removing, keep the wall mural as flat and parallel to the wall as possible. We highly recommend to keep the backing liner (wax paper), so you can re-apply the wall mural to it. It will protect the adhesive from losing its stickiness and allow you to re-use your wall mural.

# MURAL INSTRUCTION TIPS

- Note the numbers on the back sides of the murals.
- Lay them all out in order on a clean surface and match up the lines and patterns BEFORE taking any sticky backing off.
- After you are sure the pattern is correct, lay your first piece from top to bottom, about 6 inch sections at a time.
- Use something flat, dull, and straight (squeegee, dust pan, plastic paddle, etc.) to get the bubbles out of each section as you adhere it to the surface.
- This should be a two person job. Someone holding the bottom of the mural will help to reduce the amount of bubbles.

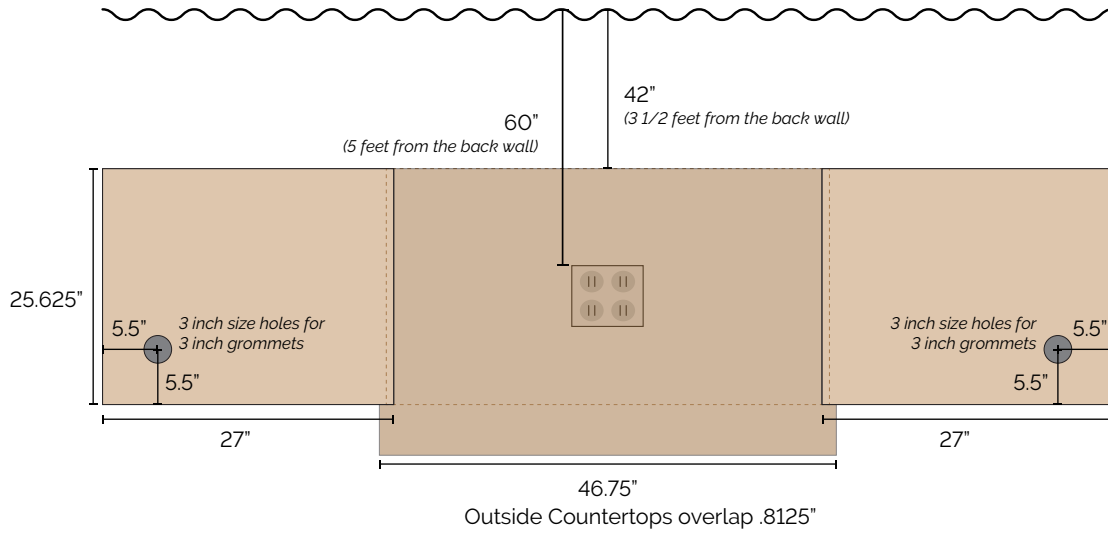
# MISCELLANEOUS – Q & A

1. VCT Tile is used in the front and back with 3-4 coats of wax and 1-2 coats of sealer
2. HVAC modification will be determined by the architect and based on local code
3. 4" for interior walls. Insulated for sound is a option of the franchise owner but not required. See local codes and landlord requirements. Door will be basic 6 panel pre hung doors from Home Depot or Lowes
4. Front desk will be constructed and installed by corp not the contractor
5. Brand of bathroom fixtures is left up to the franchise owner. Handicapped accessibility will be determined by architect based on local code
6. Tubs and High Velocity Dryers will be ordered by Corporate and sent or brought to location
7. Hot water tank is franchise owners choice, the larger the better but also more expensive (See examples listed)
8. Exterior changes of the space are typically not allowed based on the lease, thus we do not have any requirements
9. Exterior sign requirements will be spelled out in the lease. Once we have a signed lease we will send the requirements to our sign vendor for production and delivery
10. Bathroom Floor - can use existing, do not need to replace
11. Chandeliers lights will be shipped from corporate. Pendants will be purchased by contractor, in accordance with brand book
12. Trench the floor for Front desk
13. Office area - this is up to franchise owner
14. Sound Proofing is optional. The choice of product and location is unto franchise owner as needed by local code and/or landlord requirements

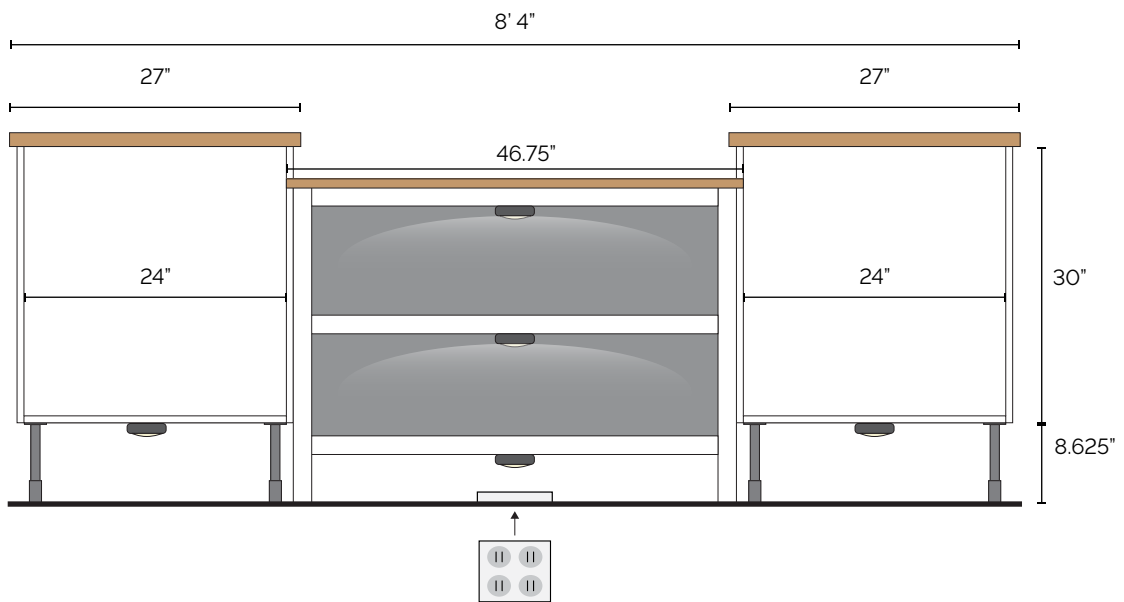

# PLUMBER – MATERIALS

## Dura Dog Premier Stationary Stainless Steel Tub (GTU50S)



### Plumbing Specs

The drain hole is 3.5" in diameter and is slightly off-centered from front to back in the tub, which puts the center of the hole at 12.5" inches from the front and 12.25" from the back and 14.25" from the side of the tub on center. The three faucet holes are 4" on center. The holes are 1 1/16" in diameter and up 22" from the bottom of the tub itself or approximately 38.5" from the floor. From the backsplash, the center of the first hole is 6.5", the middle hole is 10.5" and the last hole is 14.5".

### Additional Specs

The distance between the faucet holes is 4" and the distance from the welded corner to the last faucet hole is 7.5".

### Notes:

Plan the shop with 3 tubs in mind for when it gets busier. Install only 2 tubs in the beginning.
